John F. Kirk IV was born in Chestertown, Maryland and grew up in Orlando, Florida.

He enlisted in July 1999 recruit training at 2nd Recruit Training Battalion, Hotel Company, Marine Corps Recruit Depot, Parris Island, SC.

In October 1999, Private First Class Kirk completed Marine Combat Training at Camp Geiger, NC. He was ordered to the Marine Corps Detachment at Fort Huachuca, AZ for Basic Morse School.
