



Major Jonathan M. George

Major George graduated from the University of Colorado – Boulder in 1997 with a degree in Political Science. After a brief stint in the civilian world, Major George graduated Officer Candidate School (OCS) in August 2001, followed by The Basic School (TBS) in April 2002. In September 2002, after completing the Naval Intelligence Officer Basic Course (NIOBC), 2ndLt George reported to Marine Aircraft Group 39, Camp Pendleton, CA as the Assistant Intelligence Officer. He then deployed to Ali Al Salem, Kuwait in February 2003 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom to serve as the MAG-39 Intelligence Watch Officer, and then as the An Numaniyah Forward Operating Base Intelligence OIC in Iraq.

In September 2003, Lieutenant George was promoted to First Lieutenant and assigned to Marine Light Attack Squadron 369 as the Squadron Intelligence Officer, and completed a Unit Deployment Program (UDP) rotation to Okinawa, Japan to support exercises in the Philippines and South Korea. In July 2004, 1stLt George returned to MAG-39 to take over as the Group Intelligence Officer.

In June 2005, 1stLt George attended the Marine Air Ground Task Force (MAGTF) Intelligence Officer Course (MIOC) in Dam Neck, VA. In September 2005, 1stLt George was assigned to 2D Reconnaissance Battalion, Camp Lejeune, NC as the Battalion Intelligence Officer. In February 2006, 1stLt George deployed with the Battalion to Fallujah, Iraq and was promoted to Captain while there in April 2006.

In June 2008, Captain George was selected for the Masters in Strategic Intelligence Program at the National Intelligence University, earning his Master's degree in June 2010. Following the Master's program, Captain George attended resident Expeditionary Warfare School in Quantico, VA, graduating in May 2011.

In June 2011, Captain George was assigned to Headquarters Marine Corps, Personal and Professional Development, and over the next two years worked to overhaul the Transition Assistance Program, Tuition Assistance Program, Marine For Life Program, and other educational and professional development programs for the Marine Corps.

In February 2012, Captain George was promoted to the rank of Major, followed by graduation from Air Command and Staff College in May of 2012.

In June 2013, Major George was assigned to III Marine Expeditionary Force G-2 as the Deputy Operations Officer. Major George worked closely with the South Korean Marine Corps to expand their intelligence capabilities, as well as supporting humanitarian assistance responses in the Philippines and Nepal.

In August 2015, Major George took over as the Commanding Officer of Company I, Marine Cryptologic Support Battalion.

Major George's personal decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal, the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, and the Combat Action Ribbon.
