

Major Steven J. Siclari

Major Steve Siclari entered the Marine Corps via the Platoon Leaders Course on 7 July 2002 while attending James Madison University. After graduating from OCS and completing his requirements for bachelor's degrees in Accounting and Criminal Justice, he was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant. He subsequently proceeded to TBS in November 2004.



Graduating from TBS in June 2005, 2ndLt Siclari was assigned as a Ground Intelligence Officer. After completing follow-on training at Infantry Officer's Course, Basic Intelligence Officer's Course, Ground Intelligence Officer's Course, and Scout Sniper Platoon Commander Course, he was awarded the 0203 MOS and reported to Anti-Terrorism Battalion in Camp Lejeune, NC in April 2006. Initially assigned as the Assistant Intelligence Officer for the battalion, he was promoted to First Lieutenant in May and reassigned to B Co in June to serve as an Infantry Platoon Commander.

While serving as a Platoon Commander, 1stLt Siclari led his platoon through the company's pre-deployment training plan and subsequent deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF). Upon redeployment in 2008, 1stLt Siclari was reassigned within the battalion (which had transitioned to become 2d Battalion, 9th Marines) as the Battalion Intelligence Officer. In April 2008, he completed the MAGTF Intelligence Officer's Course and was awarded the 0202 MOS. In July 2008, he was promoted to Captain. In September 2008, Captain Siclari deployed as the S-2 for 2d Battalion, 9th Marines to Ramadi, Iraq in support of OIF.

Upon redeployment, Captain Siclari PCS'd to Quantico, VA in May 2009 to serve as Assistant Operations Officer, Marine Corps Embassy Security Group (MCESG). In June 2010, Captain Siclari was reassigned within MCESG as the Officer in Charge, Marine Security Guard School. Captain Siclari reported to Expeditionary Warfare School in August 2011 and graduated in May 2012.

Captain Siclari PCS'd to 2d Intelligence Battalion in Camp Lejeune, NC in June 2012 and was assigned as the Georgian Liaison Team – Rotation 9 (GLT 9). While with GLT 9, Captain Siclari served as the Deputy OIC, Operations Officer, and Intelligence Officer working through a CONUS-based pre-deployment training plan, a five month deployment to the Republic of Georgia, and a seven month deployment to Afghanistan in support of OEF. Upon re-deployment, Captain Siclari was assigned as Company Commander, Battlespace Surveillance Company and served in such capacity for 18 months. In April 2015, he was promoted to Major.

Major Siclari PCS'd to Fort Meade, MD in July 2015 and is current serving as Company Commander, Company B, Marine Cryptologic Support Battalion.

Major Siclari is married to the former Kelley Barz from Rochester, New York. They have two children together, Samantha (3 years) and Anthony (7 months). His hobbies include football, soccer, and golf.
