

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Good afternoon. Please review the information below regarding an upcoming opportunity to serve on ADOS orders as the Deputy Staff Judge Advocate, Marine Corps Forces Special Operations Command (MARSOC). The intended report date for these ADOS orders is 1 March 2017 for a period of approximately 6 months ending on or about 1 September 2017. There may be an opportunity for an additional 3 to 6 months at the expiration of the term, pending available funding.

BACKGROUND: The mission of the MARSOC OSJA is to advise COMMARFORSOC, staff, and three major subordinate commands in all executive legal matters, including administrative law, military justice, fiscal law, ethics, and operational law. The OSJA trains deploying units in operational legal matters, deploys legal personnel ISO theater operational law requirements, and provides limited legal assistance to personnel IOT ensure MARSOC compliance with U.S. law, international law, and governing treaties, policies, directives, orders, and regulations in the execution of all missions at home and abroad.

BILLET DESCRIPTION: The Deputy SJA will assist the SJA in advising the Commander, staff, and 9 MSC Commanders (Marine Raider Support Group (MRSBG), 1st Marine Raider Support Battalion (MRSB), 2dMRSB, 3dMRSB, Marine Raider Regiment (MRR), 1st Marine Raider Battalion (MRB), 2dMRB, 3dMRB, and Marine Special Operations School) with timely, accurate legal advice on all matters related to MARSOC activities, including military justice, ethics, fiscal, operational/international, administrative, and civil issues. Supervise and mentor legal chief and legal clerk. Develop and train MSC legal officers and chiefs. Conduct the training of deploying MARSOC personnel in all legal matters to include: ROE, RUF, detainee ops, Law of Armed Conflict, SOFAs, Human Rights Training, and other authorities. Assist in the drafting and training of legal, fiscal, and ROE scenarios in support of Exercise Control Groups and training units. Draft, negotiate, and review all Memorandums of Understanding between MARSOC and law enforcement, local political subdivisions, other military units, and private persons. Participate in planning process and conduct legal sufficiency review for all Realistic Military Training. Review JAGMAN investigations and litigation reports for legal sufficiency. Maintain close relationship with legal offices of SOCOM, HQMC and all theater special operations commands (TSOCs). Duties will include some or, at times, all of the above as duties are divided throughout the OSJA.

Do not submit any other documents. Please put all three requested documents in one PDF. If you do not have a current official photo, a locally taken digital photo in service "C" uniform with current ht/wt annotated will be accepted. A photo is considered current if it is taken within one year from the date of this announcement.

NOTE - All applicants must submit their own photo. The RLS does not review/download photos from OMPFs. All applicants that submit complete packages (RQS, Pro Sum, and photo with ht/wt taken within one year of the announcement date) will be considered. When applying for this billet, make sure you omit the personal identifiable information from both the RQS/PROSUM. This means omit the following:

3. Street address
