BILLET DESCRIPTION: U.S. Cyber Command, Office of the Staff Judge Advocate is seeking a Marine Field Grade Reserve Judge Advocate to join their office. This will be the first Marine Reserve Judge Advocate assigned to U.S. Cyber Command. The billet holder will fall under the Force Augmentation Branch of Reserve Legal Services, but will take direction from and report to the Staff Judge Advocate, U.S. Cyber Command. The particular duties will be assigned by the Staff Judge Advocate. Experience in cyber law, intelligence law, and communications is preferred but is not required.

APPLICATION: To apply for the billet, forward your Reserve Qualification Summary (RQS), Professional and Personal Summary (ProSum), and photo to <JAD\_IMA@usmc.mil> by the application deadline. Combine all three requested documents into one PDF. If sending from a personal email, please omit personally identifying information from both the RSQ and ProSum. Specifically, omit the date of rank, social security number, and street address. If you do not have a current official photo, a locally taken digital photo in service "C" uniform, with current height/weight annotated, will be accepted. A photo is considered current if it is taken within one year from the application deadline.
