BILLET DESCRIPTION: Duties include providing legal advice and direct support to NATO's two strategic military commands: Allied Command Transformation (ACT) and Allied Command Operations (ACO) with the primary duty location being in Mons, Belgium, although drill periods and annual training may occur at other locations in Europe such as the NATO School in Oberammergau, Germany, or the Joint Warfare Centre in Stavanger, Norway. Duties include providing advice and support to NATO Commanders and staff with an emphasis on international law, the law of armed conflict, status of forces and host-nation relations issues, supporting NATO education and training by conducting lectures or assisting in the writing of NATO doctrine; participating in NATO exercises; planning and conducting the NATO Legal Advisors Course and the NATO Operational Law Course; assisting in the identification of required future military capabilities for the NATO Alliance; and providing general legal support as required. Some funded and un-funded travel will be required.

APPLICATION: To apply for the billet, forward your Reserve Qualification Summary (RQS), Professional and Personal Summary (ProSum), and photo to <JAD_IMA@usmc.mil> by the application deadline. Combine all three requested documents into one PDF. If sending from a personal email, please omit personally identifying information from both the RSQ and ProSum. Specifically, omit the date of rank, social security number, and street address. If you do not have a current official photo, a locally taken digital photo in service "C" uniform, with current height/weight annotated, will be accepted. A photo is considered current if it is taken within one year from the application deadline.
