The Reserve Trial Services Branch (JRT) provides expert advice, assistance, and training on military justice matters, including trial and appellate advocacy, strategy, and ethics, to Navy and Marine Corps judge advocates, in coordination with the Deputy Director, Military Justice and Community Development (MJCD), Military Justice Branch (JMJ), and the Trial Counsel Assistance Program (TCAP) of JAD.

Trial counsel in the JRT provide experienced prosecutorial assistance with high-profile cases, specifically in the areas of motions practice, witness preparation, and trial advocacy. Trial counsel provide case management experience and expertise to junior trial counsel, and assist in developing and presenting training curriculum. Duties include drafting charges, managing/conducting investigations, witness interviews, motions practice, mentoring and supervising junior trial counsel, and briefing senior commanders regarding same. Duties also includes conduct and support of administrative hearings, legal research, Article 32 investigations, provision of administrative support, and post-trial review, as required.
