

NAVAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM (NJIS)

NJIS is a new criminal justice information system for the Department of the Navy (DoN) that is replacing several current information systems. NJIS will provide functionality across five criminal justice communities: Law Enforcement, Investigations, Command Actions, Judicial Actions, and Corrections.

NJIS is a web-based system that enables 'cradle-to-grave' tracking of military/criminal justice information at each stage of development from initial response through adjudication in such a way that the data compiled is readily comparable to national statistics.

NJIS includes the total force Marine Corps through involvement in all disciplinary/adverse personnel actions and includes actions for each of the functional criminal justice communities.

NJIS capabilities are provided in this tri-fold.





Commander's Reference



NJIS will facilitate legal and administrative processes for which commanders are responsible, and enable commanders to meet federal and DOD reporting requirements related to the Defense Incident Based Reporting System (DIBRS). Augmenting Military Police and CID reports with command dispositions, NJIS will be used to document courts-martial and non-judicial punishments as well as command investigations, document corrections/confinement actions, manage desertion activities, and track the review process of the Navy and Marine Corps appellate leave/appellate review activities (NAMALA/NAMARA).
