Conditions of Your Employment Regarding **SAFETY**

- 1. Follow the regulations and orders concerning safety.**
- 2. If you see a hazard or an unsafe condition --- Report it.**
- 3. If you are issued Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to do your job --- Use it, (and know how to use it).**
- 4. If you suffer a work related injury --- Report it to your Supervisor.**

Employer Responsibilities **To The Employees**

- 1. Comply with OSHA/DoD/USMC safety & health standards.**
- 2. Provide a safe & healthful place of employment.**
- 3. Issue PPE if required and provide training on how to use & maintain it.**

Employer Responsibilities To The Employees (cont.)

- 4. Provide a means of reporting unsafe & unhealthful conditions, without fear of reprisal, harassment, coercion, restraint or discrimination.**
- 5. Inspect all workplaces.**
- 6. Post notices of hazard found during inspections and prompt abatement of hazardous conditions.**

- ★ **You have the right of participation and comment in the installation safety & health program.**
- ★ **Access to applicable safety standards & regulations and access to safety & health program procedures.**
- ★ **Access to the installation accident and illness statistics.**
