

IGMC will be conducting MANDATORY training for ALL IG personnel. Attendance will be taken. The topic is Retaliation as it relates to reporting a crime with a focus on Sexual Assault. Policies are changing and we need to make sure everyone is clear on their role.

We will be conducting four separate training sessions via Defense Collaboration Services (DCS).

Session 1: 26 April, 0800 EDT – 0900 EDT

Session 2: 26 April, 1400 EDT – 1500 EDT

Session 3: 27 April, 1200 EDT – 1300 EDT

Session 4: 28 April, 1830 EDT – 1930 EDT

All of your personnel are required to attend one of the above sessions.

I will conduct two DCS comm check sessions on 25 April at 1000 EDT and 1400 EDT. Additional Comm checks will begin 30 mins prior to each training session. There will not be much time to troubleshoot at this point. All troubleshooting will need to be done on 25 April at the times listed above.

Access to DCS:

Step 1: go to <https://conference.apps.mil/webconf/IGMCTraining> (either click or copy and paste to your browser)

Step 2: If asked, fill in your first name, last name and your organization. Click next.

That's it...

This can (and should) be done from your individual computers. No account or login is required. Recommend that you have a headset with a microphone. You will need the microphone to ask questions.
