GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. PER REFS A, B AND C, THE PURPOSE OF THIS MARADMIN IS TO ANNOUNCE THE SELECTION BOARD RESULTS FOR THE CY2016 CONGRESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM (CFP). A BOARD COMPRISED OF SENIOR OFFICERS, CIVILIAN MARINES, AND ENLISTED LEADERS MET TO REVIEW 23 OFFICER AND 21 SNCO APPLICATIONS. COMPETITION WAS HIGHLY COMPETITIVE AND ALL APPLICANTS ARE COMMENDED FOR THEIR SUPERIOR CAREER ACHIEVEMENTS. THE BOARD SELECTED 10 MARINE OFFICERS AND 4 MARINE SNCOS.

4. FELLOWS MUST POSSESS A TOP SECRET (TS) SECURITY CLEARANCE. SELECTEES MUST NOTIFY THEIR LOCAL SECURITY MANAGER TO CONFIRM THEIR ELIGIBILITY AND APPLY FOR TS CLEARANCE. IF REQUIRED, REPORT TO LOCAL SECURITY OFFICER FOR INITIAL INTERVIEW AND SINGLE SCOPE BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION. NOTIFY THIS HEADQUARTERS IMMEDIATELY IF FOUND UNQUALIFIED. FAILURE TO INITIATE CLEARANCE PRIOR TO 1 MAY 2015 MAY NEGATE ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CY16 CONGRESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM.

NLT 10 WORKING DAYS FROM THE RELEASE OF THIS MESSAGE, ALL SELECTEES ARE REQUIRED TO ACCEPT OR DECLINE THEIR ASSIGNMENT BY EMAIL VIA THEIR PMOS MONITOR AND THE OLA POINTS OF CONTACT LISTED IN PARA 8. SELECTEES WHO DECLINE MUST SUBMIT THEIR DECLINATION IN WRITING VIA THE CHAIN OF COMMAND TO HQMC (MMAA-3) FOR OFFICERS AND (MMEA-85) FOR SNCOS NLT 30 DAYS FROM THE RELEASE OF THIS MESSAGE. THIS LETTER WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE OMPF.
