



Capt Pack is an Aircraft Maintenance Officer with a diverse background in the operational forces and the acquisitions workforce. On the flight line, Capt Pack led the fixed-wing (AV-8B) production and sustainment effort for the 22d MEU, enabling offensive air support to forces in Iraq and Afghanistan from the USS Kearsarge. During a period of split-ARG operations, Capt Pack managed the full ACE fixed- and rotary-wing complement, responsible for medium- and heavy-lift humanitarian assistance to the people of Bangladesh following Cyclone Sidr in 2007. Capt Pack has also supported sustained operations ashore, providing electronic warfare support (EA-6B) throughout the country of Iraq during the SOFA transition of 2008/2009, while assigned to VMAQ-2. In acquisitions, Capt Pack led multiple studies on the integration of the F-35B, and other next-generation aircraft, aboard in-service amphibious ships while assigned to Naval Air Systems Command. He additionally designed and advocated for the aviation suite in LHA(R) Flight One (LHA-8+). Capt Pack is a graduate of the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy and is an actively licensed Merchant Mariner.
