



Gunnery Sergeant Lloyd began her career with HMM-166 as a CH46 Avionics Electrician supporting humanitarian efforts in East Timor aboard the 15th Marine Expeditionary Unit (MEU) in 1999. Her second deployment in 2001 was with HMM-163 as the Avionics Quality Assurance Inspector with the 15th MEU whom responded first to OEF. In 2003, GySgt Lloyd furthered her education by attending the Advanced Communications Electronics School in Twenty-nine Palms, CA. After completion of the school she deployed in 2004 with Marine Wing Communications Squadron 38 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. While with this unit she served as a Platoon Sergeant and Equal Opportunity Representative. In 2007, GySgt Lloyd transferred to 1st Radio Battalion as the Signal Intelligence Systems Integration Assistance Officer. Deploying to Iraq in 2009, she was responsible for \$2.6 million of emerging technology and supervising the completion of external and interagency tasks. Returning from Iraq, GySgt Lloyd held the positions of Headquarters and Service Company Gunnery Sergeant and Operations Chief until she was transferred in 2010 to Marine Wing Communications Squadron 48 in Great Lakes, IL. There she was assigned as the Electronics Maintenance Chief. From 2011-2013, she became the Squadron's Training Chief for over 350 Marines. While serving in this billet she also became the Marine Air Control Group 48's lead Uniformed Victim Advocate instructing 65 hours of SAPR education, mentoring 13 UVA's, and advocating for survivors. GySgt Lloyd is a Level II Sexual Assault Advocate with the Department of Defense Sexual Assault Advocate Certification Program.
