1. PER REF A, THE PURPOSE OF THIS MARADMIN IS TO ANNOUNCE THE SELECTION BOARD RESULTS FOR THE CY2014 CONGRESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM (CFP). A BOARD OF SENIOR OFFICERS FROM THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS (OLA) MET FROM 8 FEB TO 11 MAR 13 TO SELECT SNCOS, OFFICERS, AND CIVILIAN MARINES FOR ASSIGNMENT. THROUGH A HIGHLY COMPETITIVE PROCESS, THE BOARD SELECTED 10 MARINE OFFICERS, 3 MARINE SNCOS, AND 1 CIVILIAN MARINE. COMPETITION WAS PARTICULARLY KEEN AND ALL APPLICANTS ARE COMMENDED FOR THEIR SUPERIOR CAREER ACHIEVEMENTS.

4. FELLOWSHIP TRAINING BEGINS ON 20131001. FELLOWS WILL BEGIN INTERVIEWING WITH CONGRESSIONAL OFFICES FOR POTENTIAL ASSIGNMENT DURING DEC 13. 5. FELLOWS MUST POSSESS A TOP SECRET CLEARANCE. SELECTEES MUST NOTIFY THEIR LOCAL SECURITY MANAGER-SPECIAL SECURITY OFFICE (SSO) IMMEDIATELY TO CONFIRM THEIR ELIGIBILITY AND APPLY FOR TS CLEARANCE. REPORT TO LOCAL SPECIAL SECURITY OFFICER FOR INITIAL INTERVIEW AND SINGLE SCOPE BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION. NOTIFY THIS HEADQUARTERS IMMEDIATELY IF SNM IS FOUND UNQUALIFIED. FAILURE TO COORDINATE CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS MAY NEGATE ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONGRESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM.

NLT 10 WORKING DAYS FROM THE RELEASE OF THIS MESSAGE, ALL SELECTEES ARE REQUIRED TO ACCEPT OR DECLINE THEIR ASSIGNMENT BY EMAIL VIA THEIR PMOS MONITOR AND THE OLA POINTS OF CONTACT LISTED IN PARA 8. SELECTEES WHO DECLINE MUST SUBMIT THEIR DECLINATION IN WRITING VIA THE CHAIN OF COMMAND TO HQMC (MMA-3) FOR OFFICERS AND (MMEA-85) FOR SNCOS NLT 30 DAYS FROM THE RELEASE OF THIS MESSAGE. THIS LETTER WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE OMPF.

7. PARTICIPATION IN THE CONGRESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM INCURS A 24-MONTH FELLOWSHIP UTILIZATION TOUR FOR ACTIVE DUTY MARINE CORPS OFFICERS AND SNCOS BEGINNING ON OR ABOUT JAN 15. ASSIGNMENTS ARE COORDINATED WITH PMOS MONITORS AND ARE TYPICALLY IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION.
