Master Sergeant Greth was born on 2 November 1982 in Danville, Pennsylvania. In October of 2003, he attended Basic Training at MCRD Parris Island, South Carolina. Upon completion of Basic Training Master Sergeant Greth attended the School of Infantry earning the MOS 0311 rifleman. Additionally, Master Sergeant Greth attended Marine Corps Security Forces School prior to reporting to Marine Corps Security Forces Battalion, Kings Bay, Georgia in May 2004.

In January of 2006 Master Sergeant Greth received orders to 2nd Battalion 8th Marines, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. He was assigned to Golf Company 3rd Platoon where he served as a team leader. His first deployment was to Iraq from July 2006 to February 2007.

After returning from his deployment, Master Sergeant Greth received orders to Chemical Biological Incident Response Force (CBIRF), Indian Head, Maryland. After a rigorous training pipeline Master Sergeant Greth served as a squad leader providing security for 2 State of the Union addresses and a Republican National Convention in 2008. In August of 2009 Master Sergeant Greth conducted a lateral move to the 26xx occupational field and received orders to 3rd Radio Battalion, Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii.

In September of 2009 Master Sergeant Greth reported to 3rd Radio Battalion and immediately attended Communication Signals Collection and Processing course earning the MOS 2621. In August 2010 Master Sergeant Greth attended Marine Analysis and Reporting course earning the MOS 2629. In March 2011 Master Sergeant Greth was assigned as the Senior Analyst for Detachment 14 and deployed to the Philippines from May 2011 to December 2011. After he returned from his deployment he was assigned as the SNCOIC of the Virtual SIGINT Operation Center (VSOC).

In June of 2012 Master Sergeant Greth received orders to Communication Training Center Corry Station, Pensacola, Florida where he attended the Joint Cyber Analysis Course (JCAC) earning the MOS 2611. After graduating from the course Master Sergeant Greth received orders to Marine Cryptologic Support Battalion Company L, Fort Meade, Maryland. Master Sergeant Greth served as a Team Chief for the Marine Corps first Cyber Mission Team.

In January 2016 Master Sergeant Greth joined Marine Corps Cyberspace Warfare Group (MCCWG) where he served as Team Chief for a Cyber Mission Team until receiving orders to Marine Cryptologic Support Battalion Company A, Aurora, Colorado in July 2016. Master Sergeant Greth served as 2nd Platoon Commander and Deputy SIGINT Mission Director prior to being selected to his current post in April 2018.

MSgt Greth is married to Denise Greth of Boynton Beach, Florida. They have two children, Chelsea Mikalah (12), and Gavin Xander (9). Master Sergeant Greth's personal decorations include the Marine Corps Commendation Medal and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal.
