Billet Description: Serves as a Regional Judge Advocate for the Judge Advocate Regional Support Branch (JRS) of the Reserve Legal Services Division (RLS). Provides regional legal services for major subordinate commands in MARFORRES for SMCR units to ensure legal readiness of Marines and Sailors for mobilization and deployment. In coordination with MARFORRES SJA Office, train unit leaders and commanders on legal issues unique to SMCR including command investigations, administrative separation processing, legal assistance, and general rules of engagement issues. Provides legal assistance services to active duty, eligible reserve personnel and dependents. In coordination with the MARFORRES SJA Office, assists investigating officers in conducting various types of command investigations. Serves as Recorder for administrative separation boards and as Preliminary Hearing Officer (PHO) for cases preferred to General Courts-Martial.
