**Billet Description:** Develops training and provides instruction to active duty judge advocates in the region through online resources, VTC, and on-site. In addition to developing and conducting training, the Regional Training Officer (RTO) supports active duty prosecution teams, including assisting with drafting charges, conducting investigations, witness interviews, motions practice, mentoring and supervising junior trial counsel, strategy and litigation tactics, conduct of courts-martial, and briefing commanders and convening authorities. The RTO coordinates with NCIS, CID, and other law enforcement agencies on military justice matters and conducts independent investigations as necessary. The RTO prepares Case Analysis Memoranda (CAM) to assist with AD charging decisions. The RTO will serve as counsel or co-counsel in courts-martial, boards of inquiry, and administrative separation of enlisted personnel as needed.
