In addition to general support to the VLCO-HQ, primary duties are to provide responsive appellate issue consultation to counsel in the field, attend and disseminate information from the Joint Quarterly Case Law Review panel, represent VLCO in the planning and execution of Joint Appellate Advocacy Training (JAAT), and provide written and oral representation before appeals courts and review boards. Due to the nature of assignment, residency in close proximity to the DC area is strongly preferred. Reserve VLCO assignment cannot conflict with other employment.
