COURSE DESCRIPTION: This ADVANCED level course provides instruction on current legal issues advising flag and general officers. Among the key topics reviewed in this course are: operational law, government ethics and standards of conduct, officer misconduct, environmental law, Victim Witness Assistance Program, and the Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Program. The course includes panel discussions and break-out sessions based on specific areas of practice. Facilitators include current or former senior SJAs from SECNAV, OPNAV, Component Commands, Fleet Commands, Type Commands, CNIC/Regions, Headquarters Marine Corps, PERS, IG, and major Navy or Marine Corps installations and operational commands. FOR NAVY JUDGE ADVOCATES, THIS COURSE PROVIDES INITIAL ETHICS COUNSELOR CERTIFICATION AND IS MANDATORY FOR ALL FIRST TIME FLAG OFFICER STAFF JUDGE ADVOCATES.
