



Guidance On Deploying and Redeploying Individuals

Overview

- Fully vaccinated travelers are less likely to get and spread COVID-19.
- International travel poses additional risks and even fully vaccinated travelers are at increased risk for getting and possibly spreading new COVID-19 variants.
- CDC recommends delaying international travel until you are fully vaccinated.
- [MARADMIN 182/21](#) will be updated post DoD Force Health Protection Guidance playbook being released.

Deployment Requirements

- Testing:** Individuals who are 14 days post-completion of COVID vaccination and meet all of the CDC criteria for the specific vaccine administered, are not required to undergo viral testing prior to travel **from** the United States **to** a foreign country, unless required by the host nation.
- ROM:** Unless otherwise required by a more restrictive DoD policy, pre- and post-travel ROM is not required for individuals who are 14 days post-completion of COVID-19 vaccination and meet all of the CDC criteria for the specific vaccine administered.

Redeployment Requirements

- Testing:** For all individuals regardless of vaccination status testing is required 1-3 days prior to travel **from** a foreign country **to** the United states and also 3-5 days post arrival.
- ROM:** Exception to ROM: unless otherwise required by a more restrictive DoD policy, pre- and post-travel ROM is not required for individuals who are 14 days post-completion of COVID-19 vaccination and meet all of the CDC criteria for the specific vaccine administered.

Self-monitor for symptoms	✓	✓
Wear a mask and take other precautions during travel	✓	✓

	Get tested 1-3 days before travel	✓
Get tested 3-5 days after travel and self-quarantine for 7 days. Self-quarantine for 10 days if you don't get tested.	✓	
Self-monitor for symptoms	✓	✓
Wear a mask and take other precautions during travel	✓	✓
