In the morning, expect vis/cigs as low as 1 mile and 500ft and bands of moderate rain for Paris and Belleau Wood from 04-09L. By late morning, ceilings will begin to lift to around 1,000-1,500ft and precip will begin to taper off becoming intermittent light rain by 12L. However, the potential for periods of moderate rain dropping ceilings below 1,000ft will remain until mid-day. Visibility in rain showers should range between 3-5SM, dropping as low as 2SM in areas of moderate rainfall.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

BLUF: Expect mist, low ceilings, and rain showers for Paris and Belleau Wood by tonight lasting throughout the weekend with bands of moderate rain showers and potential mission-limiting ceilings for the lift on Saturday.

For Paris tonight, expect isolated rain showers by 11pm as a swath of moisture ahead of an approaching frontal system pushes into the Northern Seaboard of France. Light rain showers will persist overnight through much of the day Saturday, with periods of moderate showers after 01L lasting through the late morning. Gusty surface winds will set in tonight and last through tomorrow morning, with sustained winds ranging 12-15kt and gusts up to 25kt out of the south. Temps will be in the mid 50s for the remainder of today.

Expect potential mission limiting conditions on Saturday, as an influx of low-level moisture will aid in the formation of ceiling/visibility restrictions. In the morning, expect vis/cigs as low as 1 mile and 500ft and bands of moderate rain for Paris and lift locations from 04-09L. By late morning, ceilings will begin to lift to around 1,000-1,500ft and precip will begin to taper off becoming intermittent light rain by 12L. However, the potential for periods of moderate rain dropping ceilings below 1,000ft will remain until mid-day. Visibility in rain showers should range between 3-5SM, dropping as low as 2SM in areas of moderate rainfall. Temps will range from the mid 40s to 50s.

Intermittent light rain showers are expected to continue overnight Saturday and throughout the day Sunday. Additionally, expect mist to develop across the region by 03L, clearing by 08L. Temps will be in the low to mid 50s.

CONFIDENCE: We have high confidence at this time, models continue to agree on impacts for the Paris region this weekend. However, exact timing and intensity of impacts will depend on the speed and movement of the approaching low pressure system. Currently, we are projecting light precipitation after 12L through 16L on Saturday. With that said, if the movement of this system alters, there will be potential for moderate showers with lower ceilings during the lifts and the visit to Belleau Wood. We will continue to monitor and refine the forecast as we approach game day.
